Passover banquets are appropriate all year, but are very popular during the Passover/Easter season. Many churches find that a Banquet works well on a Friday or Saturday.

<p>Purim (Feast of Lots) "O ctej ". '4234 "Hgdwtct { "46.'4235 March 37.'4236</p>	<p>Leviticus 23:4-8</p>	<p>Commemorates the story of Esther when King Ahasuerus denounced Haman's plot to annihilate the entire Jewish population of Persia. Purim is a joyful celebration of thanksgiving for Esther's courageous acts and God's faithfulness.</p>
<p>Pesach (Passover) "Cr tki9."4234 "O ctej "48."4235 April 36, 2016</p>	<p>Leviticus 23:9-22</p>	<p>Remembers the Exodus from Egypt. A great time to have one of our "Messiah in the Passover" programs.</p>
<p>Shavuot (Feast of Weeks/Pentecost) "May 49 2014 O c { "37."4235 "Lxpg"5."4236</p>	<p>Leviticus 23:9-22</p>	<p>Known also as the Feast of Weeks, it celebrates the time of the giving of the Law to Moses on Mount Sinai. From Acts 2:1-41, this holy day is a celebration of the birthday of the church.</p>
<p>Rosh Hashanah (Feast of Trumpets) September 39, 2014 "September 37, 2035 "September 46, 2016</p>	<p>Leviticus 23:23-25</p>	<p>Celebrates the beginning of the Jewish Civil year. It is both a time of rejoicing as well as a holy occasion (see Nehemiah 8:2, 9-12).</p>
<p>Yom Kippur (Day of Atonement) "September 48, 2034 Ugr vgo dgt"36."4235 "Qevqdtg"5."4236</p>	<p>Leviticus 23:26-32</p>	<p>Is the holiest day of the Jewish year. A time to consider Jesus as our atonement.</p>
<p>Sukkot (Feast of Tabernacles/Booths) "Qevqdtg"3."4234 Ugr vgo dgt"3; ."4235 October : , 2016</p>	<p>Leviticus 23:33-36</p>	<p>Sukkot recalls 40 years of wandering in the wilderness, living in tents (booths) and worshiping in a portable tabernacle. Sukkot is also known as the Feast of Ingathering - a wonderful harvest holy day.</p>
<p>Hanukkah (Feast of Dedication) December 9, 2012 November 28, 2013 December 16, 2014</p>	<p>John 10:22-23</p>	<p>Hanukkah commemorates the re-dedication of the Holy Temple in Jerusalem in 165 BC, and Hanukkah holds great meaning for Christians today.</p>

ADDITIONAL MESSAGE TOPICS

Messiah in the Old Testament

This is a sermon outlining the major prophecies in the Old Testament, which predicted the coming of Christ. It is a faith-building message that explores the plan of salvation in the Old Testament, as well as helps Christians to better understand their Jewish neighbors.

The Future of Israel

God's plan for the Jewish people is presented through the exposition of various Old and New Testament texts. We also preach a message on the future of Gentiles and their role in the redemption of Israel. A combination of these messages makes for a wonderful series that can be well handled on Sunday morning and evening.

Jewish Evangelism Seminar

This presentation is best for an evening or weekend service, or even an adult Sunday school. The topics covered by the seminar include Jewish sensitivities to the Gospel, basic "how-to" on sharing the Gospel with Jewish people, and how to answer Jewish objections to the Gospel. Time is allotted for questions and answers as well.

The Church and the Jewish People

This sermon is rooted and grounded in Romans Chapters 9 through 11, and examines the complex relationship that exists between Israel and the Church. More importantly, this message will help believers see the need for Jewish evangelism and encourage them to share the Gospel with their Jewish friends.

Personal Testimony
